Admission Notification for Four-Year Undergraduate Programs (FYUGP) / Integrated P.G. Programs with multiple-exit options for the Academic Session 2025-2026.

The Department of Higher Education Government of Jammu & Kashmir announces the commencement of **admissions** for the Academic Session 2025-26 for various Four Year Undergraduate Programs (FYUGP) / 5-Year Integrated P.G. Programs (IG) with multiple-exit options across all Degree colleges of J&K (Listed in Annexures A & B)* *and for FYUGP/IG programmes offered at main/off-site campuses of University of Jammu (Listed in Annexure C)**, for the Academic Session 2025-2026.

Admissions are being offered in more than 50 Major subjects across Colleges. Major subject offerings vary from college to college and will be visible to the aspirants on the Admission Portal at the time of Preference Filling.

DETAILED ADMISSION NOTIFICATION

ACADEMIC SESSION 2025-2026 **

The Department of Higher Education Government of Jammu & Kashmir announces the commencement of the **admissions** for the Academic Session 2025-26 for various Four-Year Undergraduate Programs (FYUGP) / Integrated P.G. Programs (IG) across all Degree colleges of J&K (Annexures 'A' & 'B') and for FYUGP/IG programmes offered at main/off site campuses of University of Jammu (Annexure 'C'), for the Academic Session 2025-2026.

I. Classification of Institutions

a. CUET HEIs

All colleges designated as CUET Colleges (Annexure A) and University of Jammu Campuses (Annexure C) will primarily offer admission based on CUET Score in the first phase (CUET Phase). In the event of remaining vacancies, admission will subsequently be granted on the basis of 10+2 merit in the second phase (Non-CUET Phase).

b. NON-CUET Colleges:

All colleges designated as NON-CUET Colleges (Annexure B) will offer admission based on the merit of Class 12th examination results. All registered aspirants are eligible to seek admission in these colleges irrespective of whether they have appeared in the CUET Examination or not.

II. Programs Offered:

The admissions will be open to Four Year Undergraduate Programs (FYUGP) / Integrated P.G. Programs for various Majors under NEP 2020. More than 50 Major programs are available in this academic session in Degree Colleges and 08 in Jammu University campuses. Aspirants registering for the admission must note that the Major programs offered shall vary from college to college and shall be visible on the JKSamarth website - <https://jkadmission.samarth.ac.in/> during the Program and College Preference selection. All aspirants are advised to visit the official websites of college(s) of their choice to ascertain specific program combinations offered along with their eligibility.

III. ADMISSION PROCESS OVERVIEW:

a. REGISTRATION

All aspirants who have successfully passed the Class 10+2 examination from J&K Board of School Education, CBSE or any recognized Board are eligible to apply. Importantly, this admission process is open to both types of aspirants - those who **HAVE appeared** in the CUET examination conducted by NTA, as well as to those who **HAVE NOT** appeared in the CUET examination.

All eligible aspirants are required to register on the Common Admission Portal <https://jkadmission.samarth.ac.in/> as per the schedule detailed below:

b. PREFERENCE FILLING:

After declaration of CUET result by NTA, the aspirants will be required to submit two sections of preferences:

I. **Preferences Section A - for CUET:**

This section shall be available only to aspirants who HAVE appeared in the CUET and will show colleges offering CUET based admissions (Annexure A) /University of Jammu Campuses (Annexure C) and programs depending on the eligibility of the aspirant as outlined by the respective Higher Education Institutions (HEIs).

II. **Preferences Section B - for NON-CUET:**

This section shall be available to aspirants who have appeared in the CUET as well as to those who have not appeared in CUET. This section will show all colleges and programs to the aspirants.

IMPORTANT : Allotment of a College/Major subject to a candidate is purely dependent on the merit and preferences submitted by the candidate. Preferences once submitted by an aspirant cannot be changed later. Aspirants are advised, in their own interest, to utilise the services available at Admission Counselling and Facilitation Centers established in each Degree college of J&K at the time of form submission and preference-filling in order to avoid incorrect form/preference submission.

c. ALLOTMENT OF COLLEGE/MAJOR

The allotment will be conducted for CUET-listed HEIs (Annexure A&C) primarily on the basis of CUET score and for NON-CUET HEIs (Annexure C) on the basis of 10+2 merit. The allotment shall be based on the aspirant's Merit and submitted College/Major preferences.

The allotment of College and Major will be conducted in multiple rounds after declaration of CUET result by NTA:

1. Round 01 - CUET (Annexure A & C) / NON-CUET (Annexure B):

The first list of allotment of all HEIs shall be published and aspirants will be required to confirm admission by paying full course fee online or hold for upgrade by paying Rs.2000 before the last of fee submission.

2. Round 02 - CUET (Annexure A & C) / NON-CUET (Annexure B):

The 2nd list of allotment of all HEIs shall be published for left-over seats and aspirants will be required to confirm admission by paying full course fee online. No Hold and Upgrade option will be available in this round.

3. Round 03 - 10+2 Based:

a. CUET COLLEGES (Annexure A & C Colleges)

The direct allotment list shall be published as per 10+2 merit for left-over seats. Aspirants will be required to confirm admission by paying full course fee online. No Hold and Upgrade option will be available in this round.

b. NON-CUET COLLEGES (Annexure B Colleges)

The candidates will be required to visit the respective colleges for allotment of seats on the basis of 10+2 merit against leftover seats and the aspirants will be required to confirm their admission by paying full course fee online.

4. On-Campus Open Spot Round for all colleges - 10+2 Based:

Colleges will conduct spot round for leftover seats wherein aspirants will be required to visit the college campus to check the availability of seats and on-spot confirmation of admission. In case the number of applicants exceed the available number of seats, the college shall select candidates by framing an instant merit list of all received applications within a timeframe, duly approved by the principal of the college.

However, granting of admissions will be based on the minimum cut-off rules notified by the Higher Education Department at the start of the Sport-round. Further, aspirants who have already secured admission in some college by paying fees shall not be eligible to apply in this round.

d. START OF CLASSWORK

The classwork in all colleges shall commence from the **1st of August 2025**, strictly as per the Uniform Academic Calendar.

Note: *Wherever the enrollment has not met the prescribed minimum limit, shifting of students to other majors / colleges shall be done from 1st to 7th of August 2025.*

IV. About the Four Year Undergraduate Program (FYUGP):

The NEP 2020 FYUGP offers a host of academic flexibility options to students some of which are listed below:

1. Multiple Exit options:

Students can exit after successful completion at each year and will be awarded corresponding credentials as detailed below:

- Exit after First year : Certificate
- Exit After Second year : Diploma
- Exit after Third Years : UG Degree
- Fourth Year Completion : UG with Honours / Research

This option also allows students taking early exit to pursue job options based on the exit stage, resume their studies at a later stage, migrate to other institutions, credit transfer as per the policy duly notified in the statutes of the Higher Education Institutions.

2. Progression for Pursuing PG

Students exiting after successfully completing 3-year will be awarded UG Degree and can explore 2-Year PG in both the Major as well as the Minor disciplines as per the statutory provisions of the HEIs. Students completing 4-year Honours Programs (available in select colleges of J&K) can explore 1-Year PG in the Major discipline of study.

3. Direct PhD Admission

Students completing 4-Year Honours with Research (available in select programs/colleges of J&K) can opt for Direct PhD Admissions in universities without requiring to pursue PG subject to eligibility guidelines as laid down by the respective HEIs).
